

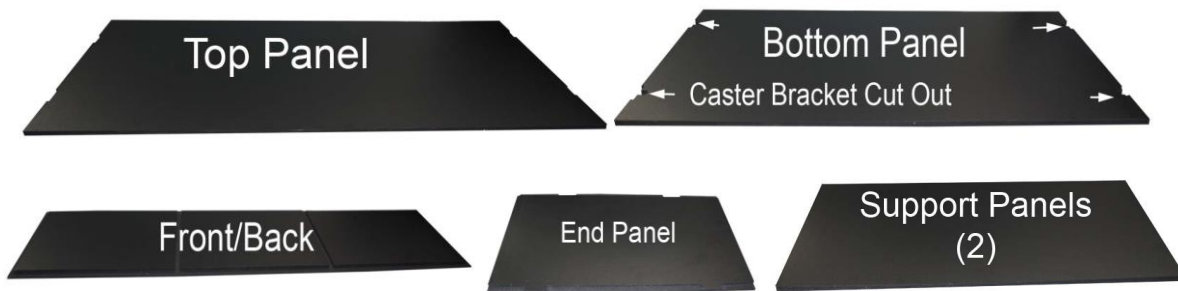
# Vivarium Electronics

## 2x4 CAGE PEDESTAL Assembly Instructions

Congratulations on your new **Vivarium Electronics** pedestal. Let's get it assembled and ready to use. First please familiarize yourself with the parts. You should have a top panel, a bottom panel, 2 end panels, two inner support panels, and front and back panels. You will also have 4 casters and 4 caster brackets (1) with screws and nuts (2,3) (Brackets, screws and nuts may be pre-installed), as well as a bunch of screws (4) and a square tip bit (5) for them to screw the panels together.



Please locate the Bottom Panel, Top Panel, Front and back (they are the same) and the end panels (also the same) Last but not least, the support panels



If the caster brackets are installed you can skip to the next step. If they are not, using a 3/8" wrench and Phillips screw driver attach them to the end panels as pictured below and proceed to the next step.



The end panels should be attached to the bottom panel with the provided screws. Make sure to keep the panel ends nice and even for the best results.



Once the end panels are secured, fit the front and rear panels in place and secure them with the screws provided. Once all four sides are secured it is time to slide the support panels into the slots in the front



and rear panels.

Now it is time to put the top in place and secure it into position with the remaining screws. Gently spread the side and front/back panels to place the top into position. Once the top is in place you can finish tightening the remaining (upper) rear and front panel screws and use the remaining screws to secure the top panel.

Now all that is left is to install the casters. Simply put the caster shafts into the caster bracket wells and



push until they click into place.
